Each Brick is \$300. A brick can serve as a way to honor someone, as a memoriam, or contain your family's name or the name of your organization.

All bricks will become a part of Southborough's Heritage Park as a lasting tribute.

Ordering opens October 12, 2024 and space is limited, so place your order as soon as possible.

BRICK DETAILS: The bricks are 4" x 8" x 2 ¼" and are engraved using state of the art laser technology. Every brick engraving is guaranteed for life! Your brick will be produced *exactly* as you indicate* – **including use of capital and lower case letters**. Included are up to three lines of text, 20 characters per line (including spaces, symbols and punctuation). All text will be centered.
